All Personnel

Health Examinations

New Employees

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that new District employees comply with all the health examination requirements of California law.

In addition, the Superintendent or designee may require applicants for employment in classified positions to undergo a pre-employment physical examination to show that they are physically able to perform the duties of specific jobs. (E.C. 45122)

Continuing Employees

Continuing employees shall undergo periodic tuberculosis risk assessments and/or tests in accordance with law. (E.C. 49406)

Employees may be required to pass a physical and/or psychological examination any time such an examination appears necessary to preserve the health and welfare of district students and employees, or to furnish medical proof of physical or mental ability to perform satisfactorily the assigned duties of an individual's position. (E.C. 44839, 45122)
