## **Employee Security**

The Board desires to provide a safe, orderly working environment for all employees. As part of the District's comprehensive school safety plan, the Superintendent or designee shall develop strategies for protecting employees from potentially dangerous persons and situations and for assisting them in the event of an emergency situation. (cf. 3515 - School Safety and Security) (cf. 5131.4 - Campus Disturbances)

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that employees are informed, in accordance with law, regarding crimes and offenses by students who may pose a danger in the classroom.

When violence is directed against an employee by any individual and the employee so notifies the District, the District shall take steps to ensure that appropriate legal measures are instituted. When the employee notifies the District of a threat of bodily harm, the District shall take appropriate measures to enable the employee to request assistance if an attempt occurs on school grounds.

Employees may not carry or possess pepper spray/tear gas weapons on school property or at school activities. On a case-by-case basis, however, the Superintendent or designee may allow the possession of an approved pepper spray/tear gas weapon that meets the requirements of Penal Code 12403.7 when justified by unusual dangerous circumstances. Any employee who is negligent or careless in the possession or handling of such weapon shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary measures. (cf. 4118 - Suspension/Disciplinary Action) (cf. 4218 - Dismissal/Suspension/Disciplinary Action)
