

Students

School Attendance Boundaries

The Board of Education shall review school attendance boundaries, taking into account school capacities and enrollment data, geographic features, student safety and transportation, racial and ethnic balance, educational programs such as magnet schools, and community input. (cf. 5116.1 - Intradistrict Open Enrollment)

The Superintendent or designee may place some students in a school outside of their attendance area to alleviate overcrowding. If available, transportation may be provided for such students.

Students residing in a community facilities district shall have priority, to the extent provided by law, for attendance at schools financed in whole or in part by the community facilities district.
