Students

Specialized Physical Health Care Services

The Board is aware that some District students may require specialized physical health care services during the school day to attend school. Such services shall be provided when the Superintendent or designee has determined that the services will fill the student's legitimate needs.

Provision of these services shall be in accordance with District regulations and guidelines. Trained and qualified school personnel shall perform these routine services in accordance with law. (cf. 0430 - Comprehensive Local Plan for Special Education) (cf. 3530 - Insurance Management)
