

Bylaws of the Board

Oath of Office or Affirmation

Prior to entering upon the duties of their office, all members of the Board of Education shall take the oath of office or affirmation as required by law. (California Constitution, Article 20, Section 3; Government Code 1360)

The oath of office or affirmation may be administered and certified by a Board member, Superintendent, assistant superintendent, principal, the County Superintendent of Schools or any other person authorized in Education Code 60.

The executed oath of office or affirmation shall be filed with the County Clerk. (Government Code 1363)
