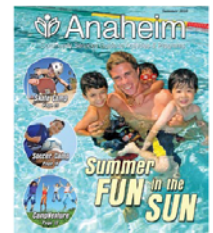

FUNDamentals of Water Polo Ages 7-12

A 45 minute, twice a week session to introduce participants to fundamentals and rules of water polo playing. Classes will incorporate various drills to enhance strength, speed, coordination, and discipline using variations of the participant's current swimming knowledge of freestyle and backstroke. Pre-requisite: Must be able swim 25 yards of freestyle and backstroke. Must be 7 years old prior to enrolling.

Junior Lifeguard Ages 10-14

A 75 minutes, twice a week session, in the class-room and water activities to introduce participants to life-saving skills such as out of water in water and class-room activities offered twice a week rescues, first-aid and CPR. Participants who meet the requirements may earn an America Red Cross Adult CPR and Standard First-aid certification at the conclusion of program. Prerequisite: Swim free style 25 yards, tread water for 1 minute and swim 10 feet underwater.
