McPherson Magnet Earns FBI National Award

ORANGE, Calif., October 26, 2010—Competing in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Safe Online Surfing (FBI-SOS) national online competition for students all over the United States, McPherson Magnet School's 7th graders won the national award by producing the highest scores in the nation.
