Dear Senior Students and Parents/Guardians:

To be considered for a California State Grant (Cal Grant) for college, your GPA must be sent to the California Student Aid Commission. OUSD will be filing all GPAs electronically unless you opt-out. If you **DO NOT** want your GPA submitted for Cal Grant consideration, please fill out the attached form and return it to your pupil's **High School Registrar by February 13, 2015.** 

Cal Grants is state aid for college or career/technical school. If you are a California graduating high school senior and meet academic financial and eligibility requirements, you may qualify for a Cal Grant award.

Depending on which Cal Grant you are awarded, you can get up to \$12,192 a year to pay for college expenses (tuition, books, room and board) at any qualifying California College, university or career/technical school in California.

We encourage everyone to apply for a Cal Grant award. To be considered for a Cal Grant award you will need to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) (<a href="www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a>) or the Dream Act Application (<a href="www.caldreamact.org">www.caldreamact.org</a> for undocumented students) after January 1, 2014.
