DEFINITIONS OF TERMS IN THE CHART

Household Size is the number of people in your household. A household is any group of related or non-related individuals, (Parents, children, grandparents, aunts, uncles, roommates, etc.) who are living as one economic unit. They share living expenses including rent, clothing, food, utility bills, etc.. A foster child is considered a one-member household if the welfare placement agency maintains legal responsibility for the foster child.

Gross Income is total household income **before** deductions. It includes wages, welfare payments, food stamp allotments, pensions, Social Security, S.S.I., child support, alimony, income from investments, and all other income for all members of the household.
